

# PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT

A representative of the Department (DoD) is conducting an assessment of you at your request, because of your stated interest is being considered for integration into the US Army Military Intelligence Civilian Excepted Career Program (Short Title: MICECP). You are requested to authorize and consent to the release of personal information and records to enable the DoD to conduct a full evaluation of your qualifications and suitability. The Privacy Act of 1974, requires that each person requested to provide information be advised of the following four (4) points:

**AUTHORITY:** 5 USC 301, Executive Orders 10450 and 10865, and DoD Directive 5105.42.

**PRINCIPAL PURPOSE:** To obtain information and records that will provide this agency the ability to evaluate your verbal and writing skills, as well as to obtain information that will assist in making a determination as to your suitability for a MICECP position.

**ROUTINE USES:** The information obtained through the assessment process will be provided to authorized personnel for the purpose of determining your qualifications and suitability for possible selection to a MICECP position. The information obtained, to include any information subsequently provided in personal interviews, may be furnished to other accredited Federal Agencies for their official use.

**DISCLOSURE AND EFFECT:** The disclosure of personal information to the DoD is voluntary. However, if you do not authorize the DoD to obtain the requested information, a complete evaluation of your qualifications and suitability cannot be accomplished, thus precluding your possible selection to a MICECP position.
