500th Military Intelligence Group Headquarters Moves to Hawaii

CAMP ZAMA, JAPAN – The United States Army will relocate the 500th Military Intelligence Group Headquarters from Camp Zama, Japan, to Schofield Barracks, Hawaii, during fiscal year 2004.

The relocation of the 500th MI Group headquarters to Hawaii is required to co-locate better command and control for providing intelligence support to the Commanding General, U.S. Army Pacific located in Hawaii.

Associated with the departure of the 500th headquarters are approximately 20 personnel and their families. With the loss of the 500th MI Group headquarters the portions of the unit remaining at Camp Zama will be reorganized.

The 500th MI Group is the lead agent for USARPAC intelligence engagement and force protection missions throughout the Pacific area of responsibility.
