

Visitors who do not have a Department of Defense identification card and wish to enter Fort Belvoir to attend the U.S. Army Intelligence and Security Command's (INSCOM) Career Fair must use Tulley Gate. Drivers must obtain a temporary pass from the SSG John D. Linde Visitor Center. Drivers must provide a valid state driver's license and all occupants must provide photo ID.

The SSG John D. Linde Visitor Center is located at Tulley Gate and open Monday - Friday 6:00 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. To receive a pass, authorized drivers must state they are attending the INSCOM Career Fair at Fort Belvoir's Community Center, provide a valid state driver's license, a current vehicle registration and proof of insurance. Call the Visitor Center for information, at (703) 806-4892.

To reach the Community Center: Proceed on Pohick Road and continue straight through two traffic signals. (Pohick Road will change to 12th Street after the 2nd traffic signal) Bear to the left at the 3rd traffic signal onto Belvoir Road. Continue on Belvoir Rd. to the traffic circle just past the Fort Belvoir Community Hospital. Take the first right turn after you have entered the traffic circle. Turn right to reach the Community Center.
